



## CAMPER & PARENT INFORMATION/ITEMS TO BRING

(Parents, please read each of the following *before* arrival at camp.)

### 1) ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE TIMES & CHECK-IN –

**Note - for 2007 Individual Camps, Arrival - Monday, 10 A.M. / Departure - Friday, 4 P.M.**

**All campers must check-in at "Camp Headquarter's" office and/or at the Depot Pavilion - there you will find your designated train car for bunking. Parents/campers, please unload luggage on the hay wagon at the Depot Pavilion for delivery to the designated train car. Campers and counselors will unload luggage at the train cars. Thank you.**

2) SORRY, NO GUM BROUGHT TO CAMP OR SOLD AT CAMP! (Thank you!)

3) **WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMP** - ANY KIND OF RADIOS/IPODS/MP3, TAPE OR CD PLAYERS, CELL PHONES,

ELECTRONIC GAMES, TV'S, COMPUTERS, VIDEO CAMERAS (REGULAR CAMERAS ARE OKAY), FIREARMS OR FIREWORKS, KNIVES, TOBACCO, ALCOHOL OR OTHER DRUGS.

(NOTE - Only counselors may have cell phones or video cameras.)

4) **MEDICATION** - Any camper on **medication** that must be given at camp needs to bring their medication in one (1) large ziplock bag with each medication marked with dosage and his/her name. Please give this bag to person responsible for checking in campers. Do not pack in suitcases. (If this is prepared in advance, it helps tremendously at check-in time!) Head counselors should give dosage at proper time and make note each time to give to parent.

**Note – Medication should be listed on "CAMPER REGISTRATION FORM". (Please also include a list of those medicines and dosage/time to put in ziplock bag.)** ALL DRUGS MUST REMAIN IN THE ORIGINAL CONTAINER. ALL PRESCRIPTION and Over-the-Counter MEDICATIONS **MUST** BE IN A PHARMACY LABELED CONTAINER WITH THE CAMPER'S NAME ON IT.

5) No camper will be allowed to stay at camp with lice or lice nit infestation. Please check for this problem prior to camp and take actions prescribed for treatment. Camper must be nit-free.

6) **DRESS CODE** - Redeemed Ranch Camp has a dress code which we believe is consistent with what the Bible teaches about our actions as Christians. Girls, no midriff exposed in any fashion, no low rider shorts or pants, or short shorts. When bringing a swimsuit, please bring a one-piece; if you only have a two-piece swimsuit, please bring a dark t-shirt to wear over it. (**Note – Bring clothing suitable for weather for the season!**)

7) **PHONE CALLS** - Family members may reach campers by phone **only in an emergency** by calling 318-382-0772. Please leave a message and phone number at the office. The camper will then be able to return phone call. *Campers will not be allowed to use the phone unless it is an emergency.* **Please do not send a cell phone with your child.**

## ITEMS TO BRING

(Parents, please mark clothing and other belongings with your child's full name.)

1) Bible/notebook/pen or pencil

2) Snacks – money for **one daily snack** is included in the total cost of an "INDIVIDUAL" camp - children will not need money during their stay.

Campers may bring additional snacks as long as they are kept in a Tupperware-type container (with lid) to be kept at their cabin. Please note for groups/church organizations: Sorry, this does not apply to you, you must provide snacks for your groups.

3) Postcards or paper/postage stamps (if applicable)

4) Sleeping bag or flat sheets (no fitted sheets as mattresses are longer than normal twin beds)

5) Blanket and pillow

6) Towels/washcloths

7) Toiletry items, etc. (i.e. hair brushes, hair dryer, deodorant, soap, shampoo, etc.)

8) Tennis shoes (**no sandals**)

9) Shoes for rainy weather

10) **Important** - Needed for horseback riding - riding boots or soles with a **hard, smooth sole** and a 1/2 inch to 2 inch heel are preferred. (Parents, please don't go buy boots - **a shoe with a hard, smooth sole with a 1/2 to 2 inch heel will suffice.**)

11) PLAY clothes (see #6 under IMPORTANT INFORMATION)

12) Swimsuit (if applicable) (see #6 under IMPORTANT INFORMATION)

13) Underwear, socks, pajamas

14) Two or more pairs of jeans (for horseback riding)

15) Coat / gloves / warm hat (if applicable)

16) Laundry bag

17) Raincoat (optional)

18) Flashlight

19) Insect repellent

20) Sunscreen

21) Bandana (to wear under horseback riding helmet)

\*Parents, the campers will have "PONY EXPRESS MAIL"; so send your child a letter or two, or e-mail them (limit of 3 *single page* e-mails / no color)!
